

NTUH Initiates Cooperation with French Hospital

Director Christian Nicolas and Prof. Patrice Tran Ba Huy of l'Hôpital Lariboisière du Groupe Hospitalier Universitaire Saint-Louis – Lariboisière (AP-HP) visited National Taiwan University Hospital (NTUH) on September 8, 2011. During this visit, the two hospitals signed a cooperation agreement.

L'Hôpital Lariboisière, situated in Paris, is a teaching hospital with a rich history. The hospital is one of the 39 hospitals and hospital groups of the Hospital Section of the Paris Public Assistance Service. It is one of the biggest adult emergency centers in the northern section of Paris. By signing this agreement, NTUH initiated a cooperative relationship with a French hospital. Based on this foundation, NTUH aims to gradually expand medical collaboration between Taiwan and France. In recent years, NTUH has not only continued to provide medical support to developing countries, but has also cooperated with medically advanced countries. This will not only strengthen NTUH's medical services, but will also introduce NTUH's high quality of medical care to the world.
