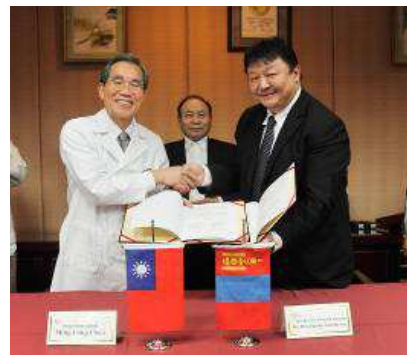


## NTUH Signs Medical Cooperation Agreements with Two Mongolian Hospitals

The director of the Second General Hospital, Dr. Bayasgalan Gendaram, and the director of the National Center for Communicable Diseases, Dr. Nyamkhuu Dulmaa, along with their hospital officials visited NTUH on Oct. 20, 2011; each director signed a cooperation agreement with NTUH representing their respective hospitals.

NTUH has maintained medical cooperation with Mongolian hospitals since 2009. Besides the two hospitals mentioned above, NTUH also signed cooperation agreements with the Shastin Central Hospital and the National Cancer Center in 2009 and 2010, respectively.
